British Swim School reminds you to:

- Never leave a child unattended near water in a pool, tub, bucket, or ocean.
- 2. Designate a "Water Watcher" to maintain constant watch over children in the pool during gatherings. Use this card as a sign you are on duty.
- Remember that flotation devices are not a substitute for supervision.
- 4e Keep a phone poolside so you never have to leave the pool to answer it, and can call for help if needed.
- 5. Be a responsible pool owner. Ensure pools have a fence and gate, children learn to swim and adults know how to do CPR and Rescue breathing
